**Project Description:**

Second Imperial Geothermal proposed the Heber 2 Geothermal Repower Project (CUP #19-0017), which will allow for facility upgrades, including installation of two new water-cooled ORMAT Energy Converters (OECs) to replace six old units installed in 1992; three 10,000-gallon above-ground isopentane storage tanks; and additional piping to connect the proposed facilities within the Heber 2 Complex. All proposed upgrades will be developed within the existing Heber 2 facility and fence line. CUP #19-0017 also proposes renewal of the permitted life of the Second Imperial Geothermal facilities, including the Heber 2, Heber South, and Goulds 2 plant facilities for 15 years.
