NOTICE OF INTENT IS HERBY GIVEN for the preparation of a ☐ Negative Declaration ☒ Mitigated Negative Declaration for Initial Study #21-0029 SMP Gold Corp (aka Oro Cruz) for Reclamation Plan #21-0001, a Mineral Exploration Project, pursuant to the *California Environmental Quality Act* and the County of Imperial's *Rules and Regulations to Implement California Environmental Quality Act* (CEQA) as amended.

LEAD AGENCY: Imperial County Planning & Development Services Department (ICPDS)

APPLICANT: SMP Gold Corp (aka Oro Cruz) Mining Exploration Project

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The applicant proposes mineral exploration activities consisting of using existing access roads and improving some existing roads, as well as constructing a new temporary exploration drilling access road, up to eight (8) helicopter landing pads and sixty-five (65) drill pads to support exploration in seven (7) Drill Areas. The Project would also entail constructing a new permanent access road and 2.8-acre staging area for access to the Oro Cruz Portal on BLM lands. The total surface disturbance on BLM lands for the proposed Project activities is estimated at 21.3 acres.

PUBLIC HEARING: An Imperial County Planning Commission public hearing is tentatively scheduled for Wednesday, February 22, 2023, at 9:00 a.m. in the County Administration Center (Board Room) located at 940 Main Street, El Centro, CA, 92243 to consider the adoption of the proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration, in conjunction with the proposed project.
