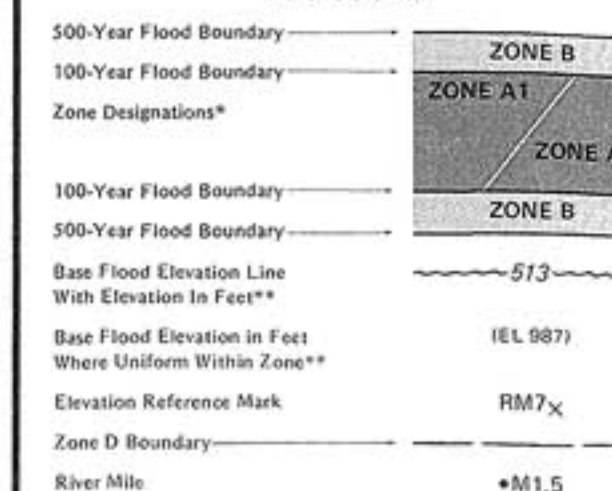


KEY TO MAP



\*EXPLANATION OF ZONE DESIGNATIONS

ZONE	EXPLANATION
A	Areas of 100-year flood; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
A0	Areas of 100-year shallow flooding where depths are between one (1) and three (3) feet; average depths of inundation are shown, but no flood hazard factors are determined.
AH	Areas of 100-year shallow flooding where depths are between one (1) and three (3) feet; base flood elevations are shown, but no flood hazard factors are determined.
A1-A30	Areas of 100-year flood; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors determined.
A99	Areas of 100-year flood to be protected by flood protection system under construction; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
B	Areas between limits of the 100-year flood and 500-year flood; or certain areas subject to 100-year flooding with average depths less than one (1) foot or where the contributing drainage area is less than one square mile; or areas protected by levees from the base flood. (Medium Shading)
C	Areas of minimal flooding. (No shading)
D	Areas of undetermined, but possible, flood hazards.
V	Areas of 100-year coastal flood with velocity (wave action); base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
V1-V30	Areas of 100-year coastal flood with velocity (wave action); base flood elevations and flood hazard factors determined.

NOTES TO USER

Certain areas not in the special flood hazard areas (zones A and V) may be protected by flood control structures.  
 This map is for flood insurance purposes only; it does not necessarily show all areas subject to flooding in the community or all planimetric features outside special flood hazard areas.  
 For adjoining map panels, see separately printed Index To Map Panels.  
 Coastal base flood elevations apply only landward of the shoreline shown on this map.

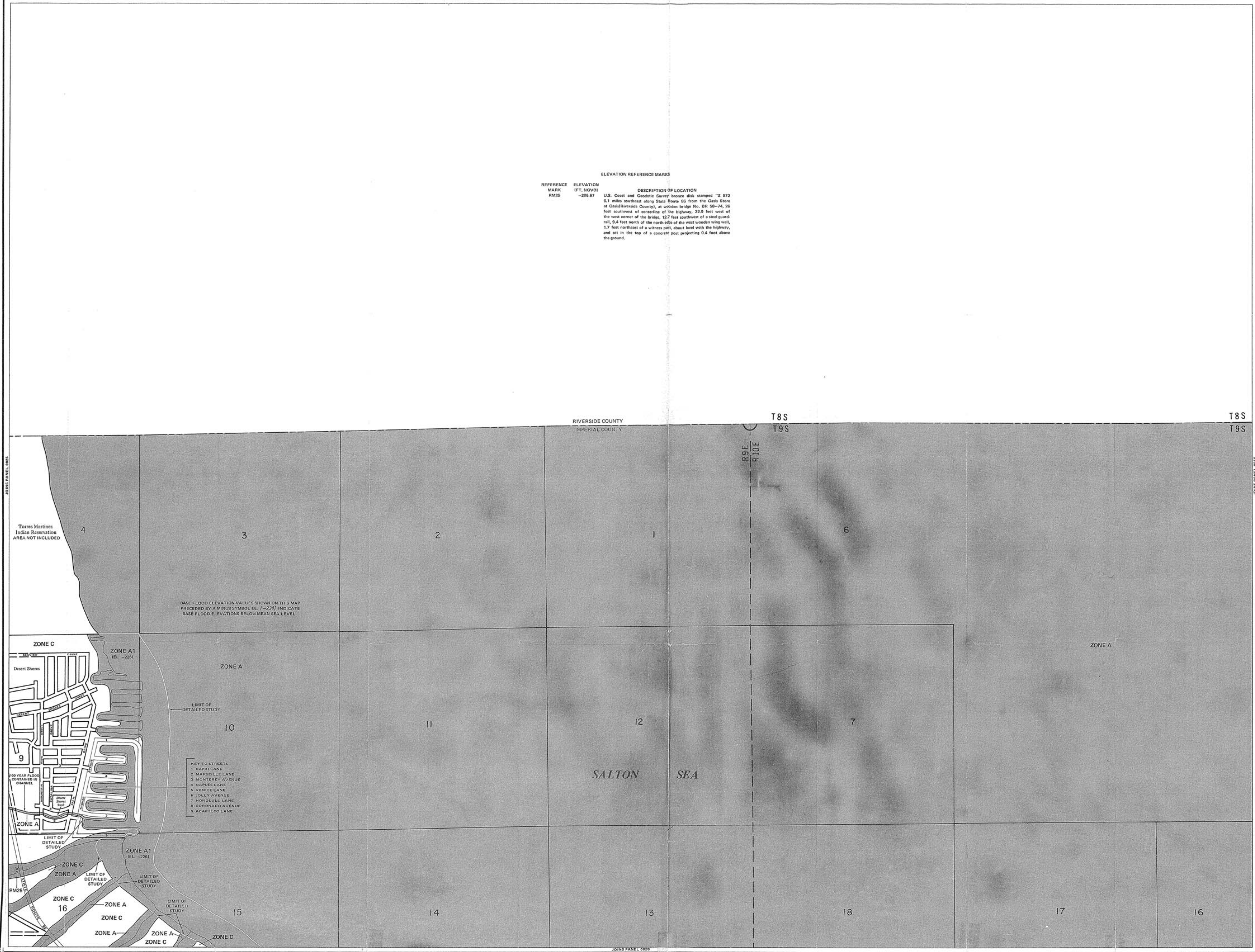

REFERENCE MARK	ELEVATION (FT. NGVD)	DESCRIPTION OF LOCATION
RM25	-205.67	U.S. Coast and Geodetic Survey bronze disk stamped "Z 572 6.1 miles southeast along State Route 88 from the Oasis Store at Oasis (Riverside County), at wooden bridge No. BR 58-74, 26 feet southwest of centerline of the highway, 22.9 feet west of the west corner of the bridge, 12.7 feet southwest of a steel guard-rail, 9.4 feet north of the north edge of the west wooden wing wall, 1.7 feet northeast of a witness post, about level with the highway, and set in the top of a concrete post projecting 0.4 foot above the ground.
