Assessment #24-0036: Applicant: Global Lithium Energy Corp. proposes Conditional Use Permit to allow for the drilling of up to two (2) geothermal exploration wells which aim for the testing and evaluation of geothermal resources (thermal and mineral) and to demonstrate the commercial viability of such in the area. The proposed Project presents a unique opportunity to construct a modern bridge that implements Best Management Practices (BMPs) concurrently with transportation amenities. Due to cracking and outliving its useful life, the existing wood bridge must be replaced to support commerce, access to the Quechan Reservation, the Bard community, and provide a safer crossing of the Yuma Main Canal.
